## **Schools Waiting on Capital Funding**

The Independent Schools Council of Australia (ISCA) has today called for all political parties to work together in order to reach legislative agreement, so that funding can flow to schools for new and existing capital projects.

ISCA Executive Director, Mr Bill Daniels said, “there is an obvious need for parties to work cooperatively so that government and non-government school students can receive needed investment to upgrade school buildings.”

“Australian school communities stand to benefit from a substantial investment proposed in the package. Indeed many schools are well advanced in developing proposals to build much needed facilities for schools and the broader community.”

“ISCA encourages parliamentarians to facilitate the passage of this capital funding so that schools, their students and the community do not miss out,” concluded Mr Daniels.
